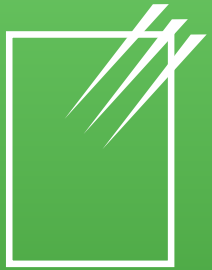

### Biography:

Professional golfer Steve Jeffress is hoping the land of the Rising Sun will also be the land of the rising pay cheque. The Port Macquarie trained professional golfer has now qualified to compete full time on the Japanese PGA Tour. The Tour consists of more than 25 events and each carries a total prize purse of more than \$US 1 million.

Steve earned his tour card for the lucrative 2009 Japanese Tour after playing himself into 22nd position in the gruelling six round Japanese Tour Qualifying School late last year.

His performance was certainly no fluke. Steven finished in 12th place on the Australasian Order of Merit making him eligible to compete in selected events in both Europe, Asia and some events in the United States.

The international golf circuit PGA Tour is a long way from the Port Macquarie golf course where he began his PGA Traineeship in 1996. During his traineeship, Steve spent time at the Australian Institute of Sport as part of an elite squad compiled from Australia's top 10 trainees.

Since graduation, Steve has played throughout the world's Professional Golf circuits. He has competed in Asia, New Zealand and the US, where in 2005 he finished 7th on the Arizona Gateway Tour Money list.

In 2006 Steve had a breakthrough win on the Von Nida Tour and won the prestigious Victorian PGA Championship. Steve has also won over 30 Pro Ams across the country. Steve is fully exempt on the Australasian Tour finishing 31st on the 2007 Money list.

Steven's 2008 record included a victory in the Coca Cola Morobe Open in Lae, Papua New Guinea in early May 2008, an 11th placing in the IC Frith & Associates Pro Am in Castle Hill in April and 2nd place at the Sydney Meriton Invitational.
